ADONI MUNICIPALITY



Overview

Adoni Municipality is 1st largest ULB in the Kurnool District of A.P. it is spread over on are of 37.12 Sq.Kms. with a population of 166537 (2011 Census). It is known for/famous for its.

Location:-

It is located 405.4 Km from Capital city (Amaravathi) and 100 kms from District Head Quarters. It was established as Special Grade in 2001.

Climate and Rainfall:-

Adoni town, in general has a tropical climate, winters last from November to February, while summer last from March to June. The annual rainfall is ___ mm, most of it received during the months of September 2015.

Demography:-

The population of the town which was 157305 in 2001 increased to 166537 in 2011 which an increase in the last decade. The sex ratio is 1013 females per 1000 males. The literacy rate is 68.38% of the male population and 68.28% of the female population are literate.

Economy:-

Adoni is a large producer of cotton and has a substantial ginning and textile industry. Second in importance is groundnut oil. Adoni is an important trading centre in Andhra Pradesh with a big market situated in the centre of the town.

Urban Poor:

There are 42. Notified slums and 4 No. non-notified slum areas in the town. APUSP Project which aims at slums improvement is not implemented in the town. Govt. through its NSDP and SJSRY Schemes certain limited amounts were sanctioned for Civic amenities and are provided in the slum areas predominantly resided by poor. APURMSP Scheme, Bangarutalli Patakam, Vaddi Leni Runalu etc., implemented in the town, but only a few important Roads and Drains have been considered for development which includes slums.

History & Culture:-

In 1865, the Adoni and the Bellary Municipal Councils were created by the British Government it is the Second Municipality in the Andhra Pradesh. Adoni is a Major Revenue Division with its Head Quarters at Adoni. Adoni town is a Major Town in the Kurnool District. It is a Major Business Centre in the District. It is also called as 2nd Bombay of Andhra Pradesh. Adoni Cotton Market is the Biggest Cotton Market in the entire Rayalaseema. Every Day 15000 to 20000 people of floating population are visiting Adoni town for their Agricultural, Business and Person needs etc.,

Mahayogi Lakshmamma temple is a prime attraction in Adoni. The guarding deity is Mahayogi Lakshmamma and the people of Adoni owe their success to this goddess. Mahayogi Laxmamma is also popularly known as Avva (grand-mother). The temple is huge with marble floorings and is a must visit.

Adoni fort, founded some 300 years back, is an astounding piece of work standing on rocks granite hills.

The Shahi Jamia Masjid is a fine piece of Muslim architecture built in 1680 AD by Madu Qadiri, the Adil Shahi Governor.

The Ranamandala Konda houses the Lord Hanuman Temple. The nearby Ramajala Lake has a legend following it. It is believed that an arrow shot by Lord Rama in order to provide water to goddess Sita during Aranyavasa led to the formation of that lake. This lake, being a direct tributary of the Tungabhadra River, this is reconstructed in 1516-1518 by Sri Krishnadevarayala Chakravarthy, provides drinking water to the entire city and is an important tourist destination for water bird lovers.

Achievements:

IMPROVEMENT % OF PROPERTY TAX COLLECTION

In view of the poor performance of the Bill Collector and the Revenue Inspectors, the collection of property tax is less than 50% as on 28/02/2016 and not predictable to achieve more than 90% in the span of coming (15) days, the Director of Municipal Administration, A.P., Hyderabad informed the Regional Director cum Appellate Commissioner, Anantapuram Region to supervise and monitor the collection of property taxes under special drive in Adoni Municipality.

In obedience to the instructions of the Director of Municipal Administration, The Regional Director, Municipal Administration, Anantapuram, Municipal Commissioner, Adoni conducted daily review meeting with the Bill Collectors, Revenue Inspectors and Special Collection staff and fixed daily targets as agreed by the Bill Collectors and issuing suitable instructions, suggestions to improve the tax collection.

Further, special teams were drafted with the section heads as team supervisors consisting of Bill Collector, Supporting staff, Engineering Water Supply Fitters, and sub-staff duly fixing daily targets form 1/3/2016 to 31/3/2016 to achieve 100% collections. The ward wise Top (100) numbers of tax defaulters were also identified and instructed the team leaders to take personnel attention to collect.

In addition to the above, the Commissioner, Assistant Commissioner, Municipal Engineer, Town Planning Officer and Municipal Health Officer were also designated as Zonal Officers to concentrate on the Top 100 cases 1/3/2016 in Adoni Municipality.

It is further submitted that the monitoring of collection of tax from 1/3/2016 on wards as per the instructions of the Director, Municipal Administration, A.P., Hyderabad by the Regional Director cum Appellate Commissioner, Anantapuram the following collections were made in respect of property taxes and Water taxes.
